



M.C.C. CRICKET LIBRARY

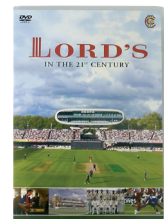

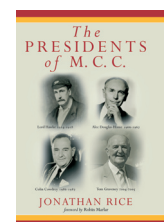
THE PRESIDENTS OF M.C.C.

The Presidents of M.C.C. is the first history of the holders of what "Plum" Warner described in 1929 as "the chief post cricket has to offer". In 1950, as Sir Pelham Warner, he was himself elected to the post and so was perched on what has euphemistically been called "the Woolsack of cricket". With some two hundred Presidents to research and a further twenty or so 'probables' from the earliest years Rice has produced a work worthy of all the occupiers of the presidential seat.

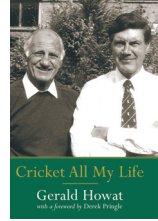

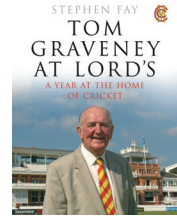

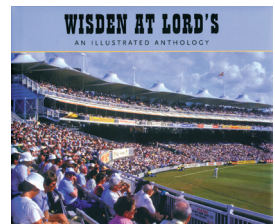
