**Match Report: Don Shelley**

After a six hour coach journey from Los Angeles to San Jose the previous evening, MCC played the California Cricket Association, North West Region, in a 45 overs match at Santa Clara.

On an artificial wicket with a slow outfield due to the long grass, MCC struggled to score runs against an attack that included two bowlers with first-class experience. After Shani Kamalia was caught in the 13<sup>th</sup> over of the innings, Montgomery and Pearson took the score to 59-1 after 21 overs before Montgomery was run out. The MCC batsmen were kept in check by the home spinners with Shah taking the wickets of Foster and Bryson in his 3<sup>rd</sup> over and going on to finish with superb figures of 2-4 from his nine over allocation. Verma chipped in with 2-22 from nine overs; Karl Pearson was seventh out, at 84 having made 33, but MCC were restricted to 112-9 from their 45 overs.

After Majeed and Mustafa put on 42 runs for the first wicket in 13 overs, the result was never really in doubt as the hosts cruised home by eight wickets with 12.2 overs to spare. Mustafa was 47 not out.
