MARYLEBONE CRICKET CLUB v EMIRATES PALACE GENTLEMEN (25 Over Match)

MCC batted first in the lovely setting of the Emirates Palace cricket ground. Openers KADEER ALI and STEVE SNELL soon found the measure of the Emirates Palace Gentlemen attack and runs flowed freely. Both batsmen passed the half century mark, KADEER ALI off thirty-six balls and STEVE SNELL off forty-two balls. Both innings included some big hitting and the pair put on 125 for the first wicket. ALI was the first to go and his 69 included eight fours and three sixes whilst SNELL's 82 included nine fours and three sixes. ADNAN AKRAM and RICHARD KING went cheaply for 0 and 4 respectively before EDDIE BALLARD and GREGG BROWN took the innings to its conclusion with an unbroken stand of 47. MCC finished on 206 for 4 off their allotted twenty-five overs.

The home side struggled against the MCC opening attack of TOM ALLIN and JONNY WIGHTMAN and after six overs the score was 13 for 1 with WIGHTMAN claiming the first scalp of the tour. The introduction of slow left armer LUKE JARVIS saw wickets tumble and his three overs showed a return of 3 for 6! With RICHARD KING chipping in with a wicket with his left arm seamers the innings had crumbled to 16 for 5. There followed a stand of 32 runs for the sixth wicket but once this was broken the home side were soon bowled out.

MCC used eight bowlers with bowler number eight, EDDIE BALLARD, returning the remarkable figures of 3 for 10 off 2.1 overs! The hosts were bowled out for 65 giving MCC a victory by the comfortable margin of 141 runs.
