Match Report: Don Shelley

MCC won their second match of the tour when they defeated Sacramento Cricket Association by 8 wickets at Sacramento.

The match, which was cut back to a twenty20 game following a two-and-a-half hour coach journey, will be remembered as Matt Friedlander's match. Friedlander followed up his bowling of 3-25 with a magnificent display of hitting, scoring 106 not out off just 61 balls, including 9 sixes and 5 fours. The match was played on an artificial wicket with the outfield grass an inch and a half long; the only way to score runs was generally by using the aerial route. MCC captain, Michael Foster, had to retire hurt in the third over of the innings when he suffered a suspected fractured thumb after being struck by a ball from his opposing captain, Sunny Singh. The visitors suffered two further blows when Ajaz Akhtar and Paul Davidge were dismissed as MCC reached only 26-2 after eight overs. Friedlander then took over as he and Will Hodson saw the MCC home with 13 balls to spare.

Earlier, the home side were kept in check with a good all-round performance in the field, only two of the home batsmen reached twenty; besides Friedlander, Paul Terry had figures of 3-23 from 3 overs with Will Hodson taking 2-25 from 4 overs.
