## **MARYLEBONE CRICKET CLUB v S.C.C.A. South West Region (45 overs)**

**Date: 19/03/2010**

### **Match Report: Don Shelley**

MCC opened their account with a narrow 14 run win over the Western Region of the USA at the Severn cricket ground, Woodley Park.

After MCC were asked to bat first, the opening over, bowled by David Pieters, contained no fewer than 14 deliveries with 5 wides and 3 no-balls. The second over included seven wides as the visitors reached 23-0. Foster and Kamalia took the total past 50 after 9 overs before the former was caught at the wicket for eleven. The tempo of the innings changed when the spinners, Shah and Rajp were brought into the attack. Karl Pearson was magnificently caught at slip off Shah for six, but Kamalia and Bryson took MCC to 109-2 in the 29<sup>th</sup> over before Kamalia was caught just short of his fifty. A further five wickets fell in quick succession to reduce the visitors to 134-8 after 39.4 overs before Friedlander (14) and Hodson (28 not out) added useful runs as MCC reached 175-9 from their 45 overs. Saleem took 3-29 in 9 overs, Thyagarajan 3-34 in 8 overs, Shah 1-27 in 8 overs and Rajp conceded just 19 runs in 9 overs.

The Western Region lost a wicket to the second ball of their innings when Mustafa was caught at the wicket off Friedlander for a duck. Chaugia fell to a return catch by Ajaz Akhtar but the hosts were well placed on 66-2 after 14 overs at the drinks interval. Thyagarajan added a further two runs before he was caught at the wicket off Bartram. The innings fell away as the Western Region lost four further wickets to reach 91-7 after 25 overs. Ali Shafi and Shahid added 31 runs for the eighth wicket before Shahid was caught off Paul Terry having made 22. Khan was LBW for a duck to the third ball he faced to reduce the hosts to 123-9 with nine overs remaining.

Last man, Shah, gave Ali Shafi good support whilst the latter did his best to secure an unlikely win. The final over began with 15 runs needed for victory, but after Ali Shafi failed to score off the first ball of the over from Bartram, a misunderstanding between the batsmen saw Shah run out and MCC won by 14 runs. Left-arm spinner, Paul Terry had figures of 3-31 from 9 overs, Tom Bartram took 2-21 in 8.2 overs but unfortunately, the MCC bowlers conceded 19 wides.
