MARYLEBONE CRICKET CLUB v SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA C.A. (40 overs)

Match Report: Don Shelley

After the Southern California Cricket Association won the toss and inserted the MCC to bat first on a damp greenish wicket, the visiting batsmen were made to struggle for runs in the bowler friendly conditions. The forty overs per side match was played at the Woodley Sports Complex which has no fewer than four cricket grounds in a delightful setting.

After losing Kamalia in the ninth over, the MCC had managed only 95-3 after 30 overs which became 100-4 in the 31st over when Bryson was LBW to Asad for 18. Rupert Swetman joined Will Hodson at the wicket and after the former was missed in the deep when he had made just a single, Swetman gave the innings impetus with an innings of 40 off just 30 balls faced, including two sixes and two fours in an over from Singh. The innings closed on 163-6 after the allotted forty overs; the total was swelled by 26 extras (including 17 wides).

Not surprisingly, having arrived in the USA two days earlier, the MCC bowlers struggled early on, with Friedlander bowling 4 no-balls and 5 wides in a five over spell. Friedlander got the first wicket when Sukumar hooked a ball straight to Bartram at long leg before Bartram took a fine return catch to dismiss Asad and reduce the hosts to 35-2 after 7.2 overs.

The MCC success ended there as Khillon and Unni put on 93 runs for the third wicket before both batsmen were dismissed in the space of four balls. Unni (41) was first to go when he was caught off Bryson's left-arm spin and Khillon (35) was then trapped LBW by Pearson to reduce Southern California to 128-4 in the 27th over. MCC picked up two more wickets but the hosts were guided home by Mavrokefolus who finished on 28 not out as the Americans passed the MCC total with 30 balls to spare. MCC conceded a total of 26 in extras (including 17 wides and 4 no-balls).
