Match Report: Don Shelley

The final match of the MCC tour to the USA was a 50 over match played at the superb Central Broward ground; unfortunately it resulted in another loss for the MCC who return home on Tuesday with a record of two wins and five losses.

After Foster won the toss for the MCC, Montgomery and Kamalia gave the visitors a good start putting on 42 in 12 overs before Montgomery was bowled by Ken Singh for nine. Kamalia fell in the following over and the middle order failed as MCC slipped to 88-5 in the 26th over. Fortunately, skipper Michael Foster was again in fine form and with good support from Paul Davidge the pair added 97 runs for the 6th wicket. Foster fell to a catch in the deep having made 66 from 67 balls faced (8 fours) and Davidge was caught & bowled for 31. The innings closed on 198-8 after 50 overs; the USACA again bowled and fielded well.

When the USACA team batted, they lost two early wickets before Sunju Patel and Japen Patel added 82 runs for the third wicket. Japen Patel was caught at the wicket off Karl Pearson and Sunju Patel reached his fifty (off 70 balls, 4 fours) before he was out off the following ball, LBW to Rupert Swetman. At 117-4 in the 29th over, the match was finely balanced but Hussan and Tummala batted sensibly, pushing the ones and twos without taking undue risks. They took the total to 157-4 before Tom Bartram returned to the attack and he had Tummala caught at the wicket with his first delivery. Gul was run out by a direct hit on the stumps from Kamalia and when Hassan was bowled by Bartram for 32, the MCC were in with a chance with the USACA on 174-7 in the 41st over. Imtiaz and Cresser took the total to 190-7 before Cresser was LBW to Hodson. Imtiaz and Sahadeo steered the USACA home with 19 balls and two wickets to spare. Tom Bartram was again the pick of the bowlers, taking 3-24 in his ten overs.
