### CONDITIONS OF USE

- 1 All bookings to be paid in advance. If not paid by the due dates, bookings may be cancelled without further reference to the hirer.
- 2 Cancellations can only be refunded or credited if notified a week in advance in writing. If you wish to cancel your net, as a result of an illness or injury, we will require a doctors certification before we can offer a refund or credit.
- 3 Bookings are accepted on the understanding that MCC reserves the right to cancel nets at short notice when circumstances dictate and when the School has not taken sufficient number of bookings.
- 4 All claims for refunds and credits must be made in writing within 6 months of the booking in question, after which period regrettably your claim will be invalid.
- 5 Indoor sports footwear, preferably white, to be worn in the nets.  
Footwear with heavily ridged, studded or spiked soles is NOT permitted on the playing surface.
- 6 Conventional **white cricket clothing** to be worn.  
Visitors are reminded that track suits and shorts may NOT be worn in the nets.
- 7 Players are expected to provide their own cricket equipment, including cricket balls.
- 8 Maximum of SIX players in a net at any one time. This condition is essential for the safety of all net users and non-adherence will result in termination of the booking for persistent offenders.
- 9 USE OF HELMETS - MCC will adhere strictly to the following directive issued by the ECB:  
'A young player (up to the age of 18) should not be allowed to bat or to stand up to the stumps when keeping wicket without a helmet (with a faceguard) against a hard ball.'
- 10 Coaching is undertaken on the acceptance that whilst every effort is made to provide the coach requested, this may not always be possible due to unavailability or work schedule.
- 11 Nets booked for children under the age of 14 (without the services of a coach) must at all times be supervised by an adult.
- 12 Attendance at the Indoor School does not entitle admission to any other part of Lord's Cricket Ground.
- 13 It is imperative that cricket equipment should not be left in the nets nor should batsmen pad up in the nets.
- 14 Visitors are asked to not practice outside the nets.
- 15 MOBILE PHONES: Should be kept switched off around the netting area.
- 16 SMOKING will not be permitted in any part of the school.
- 17 We regret that we cannot be responsible for lost or stolen property, neither can we be held responsible for any injury incurred, so please be careful at all times.
- 18 Please do not bring CHEWING GUM to the school.
- 19 Failure to comply with any of these conditions may result in cancellation of bookings.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### **DVD NET SESSION (£15 / Hour)**

(In Addition to Net, Coach, Bowling Machine etc)

- 1) The video duration would typically range between 55 and 60 minutes for an hour's session.
- 2) Clients are advised to check the quality of the video and advise the coach / administrator on the positioning of the camera before the start of the net. No refunds or credits can be provided once the session has been recorded.
- 3) DVD's provided are compatible with most recent DVD players and computers. They may not work with some older hardware.
- 4) The MCC Indoor School reserves the right to cancel the session at the shortest possible notice due to unforeseen circumstances, technical or otherwise. Clients could be entitled to a refund or a credit, contact the Indoor School for full details.

### **HAWKEYE SESSION (£25 / Hour)**

(In Addition to Net, Coach, Bowling Machine etc)

- 1) The Maximum No. of deliveries that can be analysed in an hour can not exceed 60. The bowler / delivery ratio has to be adjusted accordingly.

Sample Scenarios (1 Net):

- 5 bowlers — 12 deliveries each
- 4 bowlers — 15 deliveries each
- 3 bowlers — 20 deliveries each

- 2) For the purpose of analysis, players would be required to bowl 6 deliveries in a row.
- 3) The bowler names have to be notified in writing before the session starts as they have to be fed into the software.
- 4) At the end of an hour's session, players will be able to view their analysis in the Performance Analysis Suite. The statistical data will then be burned on to a disc and posted out to an agreed address.
- 5) The Video files on the DVD will be Apple QuickTime format (MOV) and the image files will be JPG format. The DVD is a data DVD and can be viewed only on a computer and not on a stand-alone DVD Player.
- 6) The MCC Indoor School reserves the right to cancel the session at a short possible notice due to unforeseen circumstances, technical or otherwise. Clients could be entitled to a refund or a credit, contact the Indoor School for full details.
- 7) NB: There is no guarantee that every delivery will be tracked and you may be asked to bowl additional deliveries.
