The 2010 Summer Coaching Courses will take place at Lord's between 29 July and 12 August. Each course will comprise of two full days (10am - 5pm both days).

Each course will consist of periods of batting, bowling and fielding and all other cricketing activities. Special arrangements can be made for pupils who wish to receive instruction in wicket-keeping when their group is fielding.

FEES

The fee for each course is: £200

APPLICATIONS

Places will be allocated strictly in order of receipt of application form, together with remittance. Please note that places are **not** reserved by telephone. The courses are open to M.C.C. Members and non-Members alike.

M.C.C. reserves the right to cancel any course where it has not filled a minimum of 12 places. At least one week's notification will be given to this effect.

Applications will be considered in respect of any schoolchild who is over eight years of age on 29 July 2010. **It is essential that he/she is actively interested in the game. Please note, these courses are not for total beginners.**

CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

Conventional white cricket clothing and clean, non-marking rubber-soled footwear must be worn. **Under no circumstances will studded boots or shoes be permitted in the Indoor School.** However, studded footwear will be required for outdoor activities.

IMPORTANT – Pupils must bring their own cricket gear, which should include bat, pads, batting gloves, wicket-keeping gloves if wicket-keeping instruction is required, a cricket ball which should be in good condition and a box. It is recommended that pupils should bring one or two warm sweaters, since some practice will take place outside, if weather and ground conditions permit.

USE OF HELMETS

M.C.C. will adhere strictly to the following directive issued by the ECB: “A young player (up to the age of 18) should not be allowed to bat or to stand up to the stumps when keeping wicket without a helmet (with a faceguard) against a hard ball.”

ATTENDANCE

All pupils are to report to the Indoor School Office. Entry to the School is via the North Gate, off Wellington Road. Nearest Underground is St. John’s Wood on the Jubilee Line.

The Head Coach will give a short briefing at the start of each course and it is important, therefore, that all pupils should be changed and ready to report fifteen minutes before the scheduled starting time on each day of their course.

PUNCTUALITY AND DISCIPLINE

Keeness and enthusiasm are essential in those taking part and in order to achieve the maximum benefit for all concerned it is vital that punctuality and discipline are maintained.

M.C.C. reserves the right to dismiss from a course any pupil who proves unwilling to co-operate in the smooth running of the classes.

LUNCHESES

Light refreshments and lunch may be purchased from the Indoor School Bar. Pupils may bring a packed lunch.

CANCELLATIONS

It is regretted that once payment has been received and the booking confirmed, no refund will be given for cancellation. In the event of an illness or injury, a doctor’s certificate will be required and this must be received by the office within one week of cancellation.
