Twenty20 Cup Playing Conditions

Scheduled start times:

v Surrey (Monday 25 May) – 2.40pm
v Kent (Wednesday 27 May) – 6.45pm
v Essex (Friday 26 June) – 5.30pm
v Sussex (Sunday 28 June) – 2.30pm

Rearrangement of overs: Teams have one hour 15 minutes to bowl 20 overs.

Timed out: The incoming batsman must be in position to take guard or for his partner to be ready to receive the next ball within one minute 30 seconds of the fall of the previous wicket.

The ball: White Kookaburra balls are to be used.

The result: Each side must have faced five overs to constitute a match. The Duckworth Lewis method shall be used in interrupted matches. If the result cannot be decided by number of wickets fallen, the winner shall be the team with the higher score after 10 overs, or if still equal after 9 overs, or 8 overs, etc.

Restrictions on the placement of fieldmen:

Fielding restrictions apply for the first six overs of each innings.

Number of overs per bowler: Bowlers may bowl a maximum of four overs. In a delayed or interrupted match, no bowler may bowl more than one fifth of the total overs.

No balls: The penalty for a no ball is two runs. In addition, the delivery following a no ball called for a foot fault shall be a free hit. For any free hit, the striker can be dismissed only under the circumstances that apply for a no ball.

Short-pitched bowling: One short-pitched ball is allowed per over.

Over-rate penalties: The six-run penalty for each over not bowled will apply - all sides are expected to be in position to bowl the first ball of the last of their 20 overs within one hour 15 minutes playing time. Umpires are instructed to apply a strict interpretation of time-wasting by the batsman (five-run penalties).
