Thank you for applying for the role of match day steward at Lord's Cricket Ground. Please allow a few days for our office to receive your application. **PLEASE NOTE THAT ONLY SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS WILL BE CONTACTED FOR AN INTERVIEW.**

If you are invited to an interview you must bring all your original documents to the interview.

Should you be selected to work as a steward in 2010, you will be required to complete a tax form prior to the commencement of your first duty of the 2010 season.

It must be emphasised that any work offered as a Steward does not constitute an offer of permanent employment. The Club is not obliged to offer you work on any day and, in turn, you are not obliged to accept any invitation to work.

By signing the application form, prospective stewards agree to comply with MCC regulations, including those referring to appearance.

Each steward working for MCC will be issued with an identification pass which must be worn at all times whilst on duty.
