Special arrangements can be made for pupils who wish to receive instructions in wicket-keeping.

APPLICATIONS

Places will be allocated strictly in order of receipt of application form, together with remittance. Please note that places are **not** reserved by telephone. The courses are open to MCC Members and non-Members alike.

MCC reserves the right to cancel any course where it has not filled a minimum requirement of 12 places. One week's notification will be given to this effect.

CANCELLATIONS

CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

Conventional white cricket clothing and clean, non-marking rubber-soled footwear must be worn. Under no circumstances will studded boots or shoes be permitted in the Indoor School.

IMPORTANT – Pupils must bring their own cricket gear, which should include a helmet, a bat, pads, batting gloves, wicket-keeping gloves if wicket-keeping instruction is required, a cricket ball which should be in good condition and a box.

It is imperative that cricket equipment should not be left in the nets nor should batsmen pad up in the nets.

USE OF HELMETS

MCC will adhere strictly to the following directive issued by the ECB: "A young player (up to the age of 18) should not be allowed to bat or to stand up to the stumps when keeping wicket without a helmet (with a faceguard) against a hard ball."

ATTENDANCE

All pupils are to report to the Indoor School Office. Entry to the School is via the North Gate, off Wellington Road.

It is important that all pupils should be changed and ready to make a prompt start at 10 am and therefore are asked to report to the School Office fifteen minutes before the scheduled starting time on each day of their course.

PUNCTUALITY AND DISCIPLINE

Keeness and enthusiasm are essential in those taking part and in order to achieve the maximum benefit for all concerned it is vital that punctuality and discipline are maintained.

MCC reserves the right to dismiss from a course any pupil who proves unwilling to co-operate in the smooth running of the classes.
