

Chance to Shine and MCC 'Best Cricket Teacher' Award

Terms and Conditions

1. The Chance to Shine and MCC 'Best Cricket Teacher' Award (the "Award") is open to all residents of England and Wales currently employed by a secondary or primary school and over 18 years of age, except employees of Chance to Shine or Marylebone Cricket Club ("MCC") or any companies or agencies directly connected with this Award or their families.
2. Chance to Shine and/or MCC reserve the right to request written proof of the age, identity and residence of the Award winner.
3. Nominations must be submitted by a fellow teacher, coach or pupil of the nominee ("Nominators"). However, only one entry is allowed per person or group. Multiple entries will be discarded.
4. Nominations may be made online by accessing www.lords.org/bestcricketteacher from **9am** on 26th May 2016. Nominations will close at **noon** on Thursday 7th July 2016. Any nominations received after this date will not be accepted.
5. By entering this Award, entrants will be deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
6. To be considered for the Award, nominees must have displayed the following characteristics:
 - (i) enthusiasm and passion for cricket, with a willingness to get involved;
 - (ii) an understanding of how cricket can help children both in the playground and in the classroom;
 - (iii) drive to encourage their pupils to play the game both in school teams and at their local clubs; and
 - (iv) willingness to teach lessons in accordance with the MCC Spirit of Cricket message, 'Play Hard, Play Fair'.
7. Chance to Shine and/or MCC may contact a Nominator and/or a nominee to verify facts and/or events. This should not be interpreted as anything other than an information gathering exercise.
8. The judging panel will consist of Chance to Shine Chief Executive, MCC's Community Coach and MCC's Community Development Executive, who will together select the winner based on the criteria outlined in paragraph 6.
9. The prize for the winner will be given two places in Nursery Pavilion hospitality for day three of the England v Pakistan Investec Test Match at Lord's on Saturday 16th July 2016. The winner will also be given a tour of the J.P. Morgan Media Centre on that day.

11. Chance to Shine and MCC's decision as to the winner will be final. No correspondence relating to the Award will be entered into, with the exception of a letter of confirmation of the Award to the winner.

12. The prize is non-transferable and there is no cash alternative available. However, in the event of unforeseen circumstances, Chance to Shine and MCC reserve the right to offer an alternative prize of similar or greater value.

13. The winner will be notified by Saturday 9th July 2016. The return of any Award notification as undeliverable, or failure to reply as specified in the notification within the time stated therein, may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner.

14. MCC cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any entrant entering the Award or as a result of accepting the Award. Nothing shall exclude MCC's liability for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.

15. Chance to Shine and MCC reserve the right to: (i) vary these Terms and Conditions, including but not limited to the opening and closing times for nominations; (ii) disqualify any nominee who breaches the rules or has acted fraudulently in any way; or (iii) cancel the Award, at any stage, if in their opinion it is deemed necessary or if circumstances arise outside its control.

16. Chance to Shine and MCC, their sub-contractors, subsidiaries and/or agents cannot accept any responsibility whatsoever for any technical failure or malfunction or any other problem which may result in any nomination not being properly registered.

Any personal data relating to entrants will be used solely in accordance with UK Data Protection Legislation, will only be used to administer this Award and will not be provided to a third party without the individual's consent. Chance to Shine and MCC will only keep personal data for as long as is necessary to fulfil the purpose of administering this Award.
