THIRD PARTY ACCREDITATION PASS 2020

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Issue of an accreditation pass ("Pass") by MCC is subject to acceptance of these Terms and Conditions and MCC's Ground Regulations by the Pass holder. MCC's Ground Regulations are displayed at each entrance to Lord's Ground and are available on www.lords.org.
- 2. Passes must remain visible at all times and must not be tampered with under any circumstances. Passes are non-transferable and will only be replaced at MCC's sole discretion.
- 3. Passes are only valid for the date(s) for which they are granted.
- 4. Issue of a Pass does not entitle the Pass holder access to any car parking facilities, or to occupy a seat in any Public Stand or Members' area if granted for a match day.
- 5. The Pass holder shall be held responsible for any death or personal injury resulting from the Pass holder's negligence and/or any loss and/or damage caused to any of the Ground's facilities, including any and all repairs and associated costs.
- 6. Unless specifically authorised by MCC, a Pass holder who has not been issued with specific playing area access accreditation is **strictly prohibited** from entering the playing area at **any** time.
- 7. Unless otherwise stated, use of the Pass is not valid on days of Major Matches.
- 8. A Pass may be withdrawn by MCC, and the Pass holder ejected from the Ground, at any time if a Pass holder:
 - a. brings, or attempts to bring any unauthorised visitors into any part of MCC's premises, including in particular, but without limitation, the Media Centre, the Pavilion or the playing area;
 - b. behaves in a way that hinders other Pass holders as they seek to discharge their responsibilities;
 - c. inconveniences spectators on a match day; and/or
 - d. breaches any of these Terms and Conditions and/or MCC's Ground Regulations.
