

2026 TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR THE SALE AND ALLOCATION OF GENERAL ADMISSION TICKETS AND WHEELCHAIR TICKETS

VITALITY BLAST AND VITALITY BLAST WOMEN LEAGUE TWO MATCHES

1. DEFINITIONS

In these Terms & Conditions, the following words or expressions shall have the following meanings:

- 1.1 **Accessibility Requirements:** any accessibility requirements of a Customer and/or their Guest(s), including but not limited to (i) step-free access; (ii) mobility-related access to facilities; (iii) sensory, cognitive or other non-mobility accessibility needs; and (iv) the need for a person to accompany the Customer and/or their Guest(s) to support their accessibility requirements;
- 1.2 **Adult Ticket: a General Admission Ticket for a** Ticket Holder aged 16 and over on the Match Day;
- 1.3 **Carer:** a person who is responsible for a Ticket Holder's care to whom a Ticket may be transferred in accordance with Clause 3.18 or Clause 3.19;
- 1.4 **Vitality Blast Women League Two Match:** a women's T20 match (limited to 20 overs per innings) scheduled to be played at Lord's during the 2026 season as part of the Vitality Blast Women League Two competition on a Match Day;
- 1.5 **Early Bird Period** means a period of exclusive access to General Admission Tickets for a discounted price as detailed on the Platform from 16 February to 30 April 2026;
- 1.6 **ECB:** The England and Wales Cricket Board Limited;
- 1.7 **General Admission Ticket:** an electronic ticket for admittance and a numbered and reserved seat in a public stand at Lord's for the Purchaser and if applicable, their Guest(s);
- 1.8 **Ground Regulations:** those ground regulations of MCC from time to time, which are available to view at lords.org/groundregulations;
- 1.9 **Guest:** any person the Purchaser invites to attend the Match Day to whom a Ticket may be transferred in accordance with Clause 3.17;
- 1.10 **Junior Ticket:** a General Admission Ticket for a Ticket Holder who must be under the age of 16 on the Match Day;
- 1.11 **Lord's:** Lord's Ground, London NW8 8QN;
- 1.12 **Lord's Account:** an account registered on the Website created pursuant to the Website Terms of Use;
- 1.13 **Lord's App:** MCC's official mobile application;
- 1.14 **Match Day:** any day on which a Vitality Blast Match (including any associated Vitality Blast Women League Two Match played as a curtain-raiser or double-header) is played at Lord's during the 2026 season and for which a Ticket Holder has been successful in purchasing a Ticket(s);
- 1.15 **MCC:** Marylebone Cricket Club, incorporated by Royal Charter under number RC000862 of Lord's Ground, London NW8 8QN;
- 1.16 **MCC Member:** a member of MCC from time to time;

- 1.17 **Member:** a MCC Member or Middlesex Member;
- 1.18 **Middlesex Member:** a member of Middlesex County Cricket Club from time to time;
- 1.19 **person:** shall be deemed to include any individual, company, corporation or other entity;
- 1.20 **Platform:** MCC's ticket platform at <http://tickets.lords.org>;
- 1.21 **Priority Period** means a period of exclusive access for Members to General Admission Tickets for a discounted price as detailed on the Platform on 16 – 17 February 2026;
- 1.22 **Purchaser:** any person purchasing a Ticket pursuant to these Terms & Conditions;
- 1.23 **Terms & Conditions:** these terms and conditions;
- 1.24 **Ticket(s):** Adult Ticket, Junior Ticket and/or Wheelchair Ticket;
- 1.25 **Ticket Holder:** a person who applies, purchases, holds, transfers and/or uses a Ticket(s) (as applicable), which shall include a Purchaser and/or a Guest;
- 1.26 **Unauthorised Reseller:** a reseller that is not authorised by MCC to resell Tickets;
- 1.27 **Unlawful Ticket(s):** (a) any Ticket(s) that are found or suspected to have been (i) placed for sale or (ii) purchased on any resale platform of an Unauthorised Reseller; (b) any Ticket(s) that has been sold at a higher price than its face value; (c) any Ticket Holder over the age of 15 on the Match Day using a Junior Ticket; (d) any Ticket used for (i) a prize or competition; (ii) promotion, advertising, fundraising, auction, raffle or anything similar; or (iii) a commercial hospitality package, by any person trading for that purpose without the authorisation of MCC's Chief Executive & Secretary in writing;
- 1.28 **Vitality Blast Match:** a men's T20 match (limited to 20 overs per innings) between Middlesex men and a visiting team scheduled to be played at Lord's during the 2026 season as part of the men's Vitality Blast competition on a Match Day;
- 1.29 **Website:** MCC's website known as: lords.org;
- 1.30 **Website Terms of Use:** the terms & conditions for the use of the Website, which can be viewed [here](#); and
- 1.31 **Wheelchair Ticket:** an electronic ticket for admittance to Lord's for a person using a wheelchair within a designated wheelchair space at Lord's.

2. GENERAL

- 2.1 These Terms & Conditions constitute the terms and conditions that apply to the purchase, transfer, sale and/or use of any Ticket(s).
- 2.2 In order to purchase any Tickets, each Purchaser must have their own Lord's Account.
- 2.3 All Tickets are subject to the Ground Regulations, which are incorporated into these Terms & Conditions. By purchasing a Ticket(s), the Ticket Holder agrees to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these Terms & Conditions, including the Ground Regulations.
- 2.4 MCC shall be entitled to confiscate or invalidate any Ticket(s) which is offered for sale or acquired in contravention of these Terms & Conditions or where there is a breach of the Ground Regulations and without refund or compensation.
- 2.5 Any Purchaser agrees to bring the Terms & Conditions, including the Ground Regulations, to the attention of their Guests and confirm that anyone to whom they sell, transfer or allocate Tickets has also read and agreed to comply with these Terms & Conditions. Guests are

deemed to have accepted these Terms & Conditions by using the Ticket.

3. SALE OF TICKETS

- 3.1 The price for a Ticket(s) shall be set out on the Platform at the time of purchase and will be quoted in Pounds Sterling. Unless expressly stated otherwise, the price is inclusive of VAT.
- 3.2 MCC accepts all major debit and credit cards for payment for the Ticket(s).
- 3.3 MCC shall not be responsible for any exchange rates, fees or charges levied by the Purchaser's bank or payment card provider.
- 3.4 When making a purchase pursuant to this Clause 3.4, MCC uses a third-party payment processor (**Payment Processor**) to process the payment. The processing of the payment will be subject to the terms, conditions and privacy policies of the Payment Processor in addition to these Terms & Conditions.

Priority Period

- 3.5 Ticket(s) are offered for sale to Members during the Priority Period.
- 3.6 Any Member can purchase a Ticket on the Platform on a first come, first served basis, subject to availability via an online queuing system during the Priority Period. Payment must be made in full and cleared funds at the time of purchase.
- 3.7 Those who have been successful in purchasing Ticket(s) under Clause 3.6, will be notified via email to the email address registered to the Purchaser's Lord's Account.

Early Bird Period

- 3.8 If Tickets are available following the Priority Period, Tickets shall be offered for sale during the Early Bird Period.
- 3.9 Any person can purchase a Ticket online via the Platform on a first come, first served basis, subject to availability via an online queuing system during the Early Bird Period. Payment must be made in full and cleared funds at the time of purchase.
- 3.10 Those who have been successful in purchasing Ticket(s) under Clause 3.9, will be notified via email to the email address registered to the Purchaser's Lord's Account.

General Sale

- 3.11 If Tickets are available following the Early Bird Period, Tickets shall be offered for sale on a first come, first served basis, subject to availability.
- 3.12 If Clause 3.11 applies, any person can purchase a Ticket online only via the Platform and payment must be made in full and cleared funds at the time of purchase.
- 3.13 Those who have been successful in purchasing a Ticket(s) under Clause 3.12 will be notified via email to the email address registered to the Purchaser's Lord's Account.
- 3.14 The Ticket Holder is not guaranteed an uninterrupted and/or uninhibited view of any Match Day from the position provided. MCC does not guarantee protection from the elements or weather from any seat and the Ticket Holder acknowledges and accepts that they are required to take appropriate care for their sun protection and hydration.

Accessibility Requirements and Wheelchair Tickets

- 3.15 If a Purchaser has any Accessibility Requirements, they should email Club Services at

accessibility.tickets@mcc.org.uk or telephone 020 7432 1010 and subject to availability, MCC shall endeavour to satisfy any Accessibility Requirements.

- 3.16 Any Purchaser who has purchased a Wheelchair Ticket or made a request under Clause 3.15 may be required by MCC to provide supporting documentation including without limitation a copy of Personal Independence Payment (**PIP**) or Disability Living Allowance (**DLA**) or by presentation of their Nimbus Card. Any Purchaser who fails to provide such supporting documentation on MCC's request may have their Wheelchair Ticket cancelled or may not have their Accessibility Requirements met without any liability to MCC.
- 3.17 Purchasers who have been successful in purchasing a Ticket(s), shall be permitted to transfer the Ticket(s) to a Guest subject to the following conditions:
- 3.17.1 the Ticket is for the Guest's personal use and free of any consideration;
- 3.17.2 the Purchaser draws their Guest's attention to these Terms & Conditions, including the Ground Regulations, so that by accepting the transfer of a Ticket, the Guest also agrees to be subject to them; and
- 3.17.3 the Guest shall have no right to transfer the Ticket under these Terms & Conditions.
- 3.18 In the event that MCC permits a Carer to accompany a Purchaser on a Match Day to support any Accessibility Requirements, MCC shall provide the Purchaser with an Adult Ticket free of charge provided that the person using the Adult Ticket shall only attend the Match Day with the Purchaser and not transfer the Ticket.
- 3.19 MCC shall provide a Purchaser with a Wheelchair Ticket with an Adult Ticket free of charge provided that person using the Adult Ticket shall:
- 3.19.1 be considered as a Carer;
- 3.19.2 accompany the Purchaser to Lord's and attend the Match Day with the Purchaser; and
- 3.19.3 not transfer the Ticket.

Errors

- 3.20 MCC shall endeavour to ensure that pricing and ticketing information provided is correct and accurate, however in some instances an error may occur. If MCC becomes aware of any error after purchase, MCC will endeavour to inform the Purchaser as soon as reasonably practicable via email to the email address registered to the Purchaser's Lord's Account. The Purchaser will have the option to (i) reconfirm the order at the correct price and/or information; or (ii) cancel the order. The Purchaser must confirm which option to MCC within seven days of receiving MCC's email under this Clause 3.20. If the Purchaser fails to notify MCC within the seven days, MCC will treat the purchase as cancelled. If the purchase is cancelled pursuant to this Clause 3.20, an automatic refund of the price for the Ticket will be made within 30 days of MCC confirming cancellation to the credit or debit card used by the Purchaser to make the purchase of the Ticket(s) and any Ticket (if already issued) shall be voided.

4. DELIVERY OF TICKETS

- 4.1 All Tickets shall be issued electronically prior to the Match Day by MCC as a digital ticket through the Lord's App via the Purchaser's Lord's Account or as otherwise agreed by MCC. Ticket Holders are required to ensure that they have a smartphone device with the latest version of the Lord's App. Tickets must be presented and scanned to gain entry to Lord's.
- 4.2 By accepting these Terms & Conditions, the Ticket Holder confirms that they have a suitable mobile device to use the Lord's App to display and use the Ticket(s).

- 4.3 Each Ticket Holder should download the Lord's App and provide all information reasonably required by MCC from time to time and Clause 16 shall apply accordingly.
- 4.4 If a Ticket Holder:
- 4.4.1 has issues with the retrieval of the Tickets through the Lord's App, the Ticket Holder should inform MCC by contacting Club Services at clubservices@mcc.org.uk or telephone 020 7432 1000 and in any event no later than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the relevant Match Day; or
 - 4.4.2 does not have a mobile device, the Ticket Holder should inform MCC by contacting Club Services at clubservices@mcc.org.uk or telephone 020 7432 1010 and in any event no later than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the relevant Match Day.
- 4.5 MCC reserves the right not to replace or accept any Ticket that has been lost, stolen, forgotten, defaced, damaged or forged, or any Ticket which is unreadable or incomplete, as applicable.

5. ENTRY AND USE OF TICKETS AT LORD'S

- 5.1 To gain entry into Lord's a valid Ticket must be presented in whole form and not defaced or damaged in any way.
- 5.2 Entry to Lord's will be permitted after the gate opening hours as specified on the Ticket, the Lord's App or as published on the Website, which times may be subject to update from time to time, including the start time of a Vitality Blast Match or a Vitality Blast Women League Two Match.
- 5.3 In addition to the Ground Regulations, entry to Lord's will be subject to such health, safety and security rules and regulations which may be in place from time to time, including without limitation in relation to any public health emergency.
- 5.4 The Ticket Holder is responsible for the Ticket(s) that have been delivered to the Purchaser and shall ensure:
- 5.4.1 the Ticket(s) can be displayed correctly to be scanned by MCC on the Match Day;
 - 5.4.2 the Ticket(s) is displayed within the Lord's App as MCC cannot accept screenshots, photographs or printed versions of the Tickets, unless Clause 4.4.2 applies; and
 - 5.4.3 the mobile device displaying the Ticket has enough battery power and is fully functional (if the screen of the mobile device is damaged MCC may be unable to scan the Ticket).
- MCC will not be obliged to reissue any Ticket(s) or be liable for any loss, damage, injury or disappointment suffered in connection with a Ticket Holder's failure to comply with this Clause 5.4 and which may result in the Ticket Holder being refused entry to Lord's.
- 5.5 The Ticket Holder must retain the Ticket (e.g. on a smartphone mobile device which displays the Ticket, if applicable) at all times.
- 5.6 A Ticket permits a Ticket Holder to occupy the seat indicated on the Ticket during the Match Day and unless Clause 5.7 applies, a Ticket Holder agrees to (i) remain in that allocated seat wherever possible and shall in no event sit in any seat even if other seats appear empty; or (ii) not stand in a seated area and/or in an accessibility area during play.
- 5.7 MCC may from time to time allocate such alternative seat to a Ticket Holder at its discretion.
- 5.8 The QR code on each Ticket will only admit one entry per Ticket. The first Ticket scanned at the entry gate to Lord's will allow entry, however, subsequent scans will not allow entry into

Lord's.

- 5.9 A Ticket Holder is permitted to exit and re-enter Lord's on a Match Day provided that on exit the Ticket Holder must indicate the intention to gate staff to re-enter Lord's on the Match Day and thereafter the Ticket shall be scanned on exit and rescanned on entry to Lord's to allow re-entry. The same Ticket must be used during this process. MCC reserves the right to refuse entry to any person who attempts to re-enter Lord's without having had their Ticket correctly scanned upon leaving Lord's, or without having followed such other process for monitoring re-entry to Lord's as may be determined at the sole discretion of MCC.
- 5.10 Each Ticket Holder acknowledges that their entry, presence and/or movement at Lord's is at their own risk this includes without limitation an acknowledgment to the risk of being struck by a cricket ball on the Match Day. MCC will not be responsible for paying any compensation for any injury, illness, loss or damage suffered by a Ticket Holder unless Clause 9.4 applies.
- 5.11 No Ticket Holder who is subject to a ban or suspension imposed and/or recognised by MCC, the ICC, the ECB or any other ICC Member as a result of a breach of any applicable MCC, ICC, ECB or other ICC Member rules, regulations, codes or directives shall be permitted to enter Lord's and any such person found within Lord's on the Match Day shall be liable to immediate removal from Lord's without any further liability to the Ticket Holder.

6. BREACH AND CONSEQUENCES

- 6.1 All Ticket Holders agree, without prejudice to any other rights which MCC may have, that if a Ticket Holder breaches these Terms & Conditions they will:
- 6.1.1 be refused entry to and/or ejected from Lord's without refund or compensation;
 - 6.1.2 have the Ticket confiscated and/or cancelled without refund or compensation;
 - 6.1.3 have any such other action taken against them as may be determined by MCC; and/or
 - 6.1.4 have legal action taken against them in connection with such matters.
- 6.2 Any person who has acquired an Unlawful Ticket may be prohibited and disqualified from purchasing tickets for and/or entering Lord's for future events for a period of time as determined by MCC.
- 6.3 In addition to Clause 6.1, if a Member acquires an Unlawful Ticket, such a Member may be referred to MCC's disciplinary panel.
- 6.4 If MCC reasonably suspects a Ticket Holder has committed a ticket touting offence, it will notify the ECB, who may in turn notify the First-Class Counties and/or the relevant law enforcement authorities. By purchasing or being allocated any Ticket(s), the Ticket Holder accepts that MCC may disclose the Ticket Holder's details for these purposes, including the Ticket Holder's personal details, information about the ticket touting offence and about Ticket purchases (including payment details).

7. REFUNDS

- 7.1 Unless otherwise agreed by MCC, no refunds will be given, other than those covered under the appropriate refund scheme set out in this Clause 7.
- 7.2 If, because of weather conditions, play on the Match Day does not take place, or the total amount of play across the Vitality Blast Match is restricted to 9.5 overs or fewer, and no result is obtained in the Vitality Blast Match, the Purchaser will be entitled to an automatic refund of the price paid for the Ticket. No refund will be given where a result is achieved in the Vitality Blast Match, including where a result is obtained under the applicable playing

conditions with a minimum of five overs per side. Any applicable refund will be made following the Match Day to the original credit or debit card used by the Purchaser to make the purchase of the Ticket(s).

8. EVENTS OUTSIDE MCC'S CONTROL

MCC will not be liable for any failure (whether complete or partial) or delay in relation to the performance of its obligations under these Terms & Conditions where the failure or delay arises from an event beyond its control and MCC reserves the right to cancel any Ticket without notice. In such cases, the Purchaser may be entitled to a refund for the price of the Ticket.

9. LIABILITY

9.1 Subject to Clause 9.4, MCC shall not be liable for:

9.1.1 any injury, loss or damage including (without limitation) bodily or mental harm, personal property damage or any loss, loss of profit, business or opportunity, indirect or consequential loss, special damages or any other loss and/or harm howsoever arising whatsoever on a Match Day nor for any refund, loss or damage to or theft of their property howsoever such injury, loss or damage may be caused, and a Ticket Holder agrees that no claim, complaint or proceeding will be brought in relation to the foregoing and shall indemnify MCC in respect of any liability for any such injury, loss or damage;

9.1.2 whether foreseeable or not and whether as a result of strike action or otherwise, any indirect or consequential loss or damages or the costs of any personal travel or accommodation or any other arrangements howsoever made in relation to any Match Day under any circumstances;

9.1.3 interruption, delay and/or restriction of the ground on a Match Day caused by the position of the Ticket Holder's seat and/or the actions of other spectators;

9.1.4 refund, loss, damage, injury or disappointment suffered for failure to download or bring a Ticket on the Match Day; and/or

9.1.5 any failure, delay, refund, loss, damage or expense caused by circumstances outside MCC's reasonable control.

9.2 Subject to Clause 9.4, MCC is not responsible for any:

9.2.1 technical glitches or malfunctions or any other problems out of its control that result in a purchase not being properly received by MCC; and

9.2.2 damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered as a result of not obtaining a Ticket.

9.3 MCC does not make or give, and no staff or official of MCC has any authority to make or give, any representation, condition or warranty regarding the amount of play occurring on the Match Day, and any such representation, condition or warranty is hereby excluded.

9.4 Nothing in these Terms & Conditions seeks to exclude or limit MCC's liability for death or personal injury caused by its negligence or any other type of liability which cannot be excluded or limited by applicable law.

9.5 MCC's total liability in all other circumstances shall otherwise, under, or in connection with these Terms & Conditions will not exceed the face value of the Ticket(s) as at the date such liability arose.

- 9.6 Each Ticket Holder shall indemnify and hold MCC harmless from and against all loss, damages and liabilities, including (without limitation) bodily or mental harm, personal property damage or loss, loss of profit, business or opportunity, indirect or consequential loss, special damages or any other loss and/or harm howsoever arising (including but not limited to the costs of enforcement or attempted enforcement of these conditions), suffered or incurred by any of them in connection with, resulting from, or arising out of, a breach by the Ticket Holder of any of these Terms & Conditions.

10. RETURNS

Unless otherwise agreed by MCC, a Purchaser is unable to return a Ticket for any Match Day to MCC.

11. ANTI-DISCRIMINATION

- 11.1 MCC is committed to promoting diversity and equal opportunities and expects all visitors to Lord's to share MCC's commitment.
- 11.2 Ticket Holders must at all times refrain from any conduct or behaviour which is discriminatory on the grounds of: age; disability, gender reassignment, marital or civil partnership status, pregnancy or maternity, race, religion and belief, sex or sexual orientation.
- 11.3 If any Ticket Holder engages in any conduct or behaviours as referred to in Clause 11.2, as determined by MCC in its reasonable opinion, Clause 6 shall apply.

12. AMENDMENT

MCC reserves the right to make amendments to these Terms & Conditions from time to time. Up to date versions of these Terms & Conditions will be made available as soon as practicable on the Website.

13. STATUTORY RIGHTS

These Terms & Conditions shall not affect a Ticket Holder's statutory rights as a consumer.

14. WAIVER

No failure or delay by MCC to exercise any right (in whole or in part) under these Terms & Conditions shall constitute a waiver of that right, nor restrict any further exercise of that right. To the extent that MCC is prevented or delayed by matters beyond its reasonable control from performing any of its obligation(s) under these Terms & Conditions, MCC shall be relieved of any liability to any Ticket Holder for failure to perform or for delay in performing any such obligation(s).

15. CONTRACTS (RIGHTS OF THIRD PARTIES) ACT 1999

No third party shall have the right to enforce any of these Terms & Conditions under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999. However, it is agreed and acknowledged that on account of Clause 2.5 and Clause 3.17.2, MCC shall have the benefit of and be entitled to enforce all the provisions of these Terms & Conditions against Guests notwithstanding that they may not be a party hereto.

16. PERSONAL DATA

The Ticket Holder irrevocably and unconditionally consents to the collection, use and insertion into a database by or on behalf of MCC of any personal information provided by the Purchaser and any other Ticket Holder in accordance with Data Protection Legislation for the purposes of implementation of these Terms & Conditions, including for administration, communication, enforcement and access control purposes. MCC shall process any personal information of any Ticket Holder in accordance with the Privacy Notice which may be viewed

at www.lords.org/privacynotice.

17. SEVERANCE

Each of the provisions set out in these Terms & Conditions shall be severally enforceable. Notwithstanding that the whole or any part of any provision(s) of these Terms & Conditions may be declared void, ineffective or unenforceable in any respect by any competent court in any jurisdiction, the provision(s) in question (or part thereof, as the case may be) shall be severed to the extent necessary and the other provision(s) of these Terms & Conditions and the remainder of the provision(s) in question (as applicable) shall continue in full force and effect.

18. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

The Ticket Holder shall not use, alter, copy or otherwise deal with any of the symbols, trade marks, logos and/or intellectual property appearing on a Ticket, and shall not purport or attempt to create any Ticket-related intellectual property rights.

19. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

These Terms & Conditions shall be governed by English law. Any dispute arising from or in connection with these Terms & Conditions shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts. Notwithstanding the foregoing, MCC reserves the right to pursue legal proceedings in a competent court of the Ticket Holder's domicile, where such proceedings shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with English law.
