



MCC MEN'S PLAYERS & FIXTURES SUB-COMMITTEE
TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. Composition

The sub-committee will comprise of up to 12 Members (ideally who have qualified as Playing Members and been a Match Manager), the Chair of the Tours Working Group and the North & South Mentors.

In attendance: Director of Cricket & Operations, Head of Cricket, Cricket Office Manager, Head of Cricket Projects, Cricket Office Administrator (and for meetings to discuss elections and fixtures the 14 Area Representatives).

2. Specific Remit of MCC Men's Players & Fixtures sub-committee

- To oversee the playing personnel of the Club (both Candidates and Members) both monitoring their playing requirements and disciplinary procedures and to continually monitor the MCC Out-Match Fixture List.
- To work with the Tours Working Group to assess suitability of touring destinations and select touring squads.

3. The approach of the Men's Players & Fixtures committee

(a) General

- The sub-committee will meet three times per year.
- Members of the sub-committee should be available to give their views on MCC cricket related matters between meetings.

(b) Guiding Principles

- The Men's Players & Fixtures sub-committee will, where appropriate, be guided by the key priorities in the Club's Strategic Plan.
- As well as having the interests of Members at the forefront of thinking, the sub-committee will examine how it can work effectively with other cricketing organisations.

(c) Specific

The MCC Men's Players & Fixtures sub-committee will take reports on, provide feedback on, and make decisions on MCC Members cricket-related activities:

- the selection / non-selection of probationary candidates;
- assessing the candidates' suitability for Membership after their probationary period;
- adjudicating on Members who do not fulfil their post-qualification matches (currently 20 days of cricket in 5 years)
- reviewing the fixture list to ensure the Club's games are valued and worthwhile for MCC and our opposition alike;
- dealing with any disciplinary processes arising from cricket-related incidents by players and candidates;
- working with the Tours Working Party on the suitability of touring destinations and touring squads.

4. Reporting Lines

The Men's Players & Fixtures sub-committee will report to the Cricket committee and provide updates, both orally and, where appropriate, in writing at committee meetings.
